



COULD YOU BE A PATRON?

The Berwick Literary Festival (first held in 2014) is now an established part of the town's cultural life, taking place each October. The Festival promotes the written and spoken word in all forms, through an extensive free programme of work in all the town's schools; by a schools' short story competition and poetry reading in care homes; and through a three-day schedule of talks and workshops in local venues by well-known authors and speakers. It is also one of the few literary festivals that makes a feature of poetry. More information and a flavour of previous Festivals can be seen on our website.

The financial support of our Patrons is crucial in enabling the Festival to run. It is a charity and attracts grants and sponsorship, but it is run by volunteers and is deliberately not profit-making. There is no college or museum in Berwick to support it, unlike Carlisle or Durham. To develop the Festival we are seeking to recruit new Patrons to help provide core income. The cost is £25 (more if you wish!) per individual Patron. In return, your name will, unless stated otherwise, be included in the Festival's website and any printed programme.

Covid has forced some changes in our usual practice: the 2020 Festival will be held entirely online and free and there will be a Patrons-only online talk in the summer to launch the 2020 programme. (Normally, Patrons have priority booking before the box office opens to the public. All Patrons are offered two free tickets for one of the talks for which there is a charge and receive a discount on a weekend pass). When 'normality' returns we hope to widen the Patrons scheme with new events.
